According to *MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers*, 7th ed., the citation for an electronic source should include both the *name of the website in italics* and the website publisher. If no publisher is listed, use N. p. to denote no publisher name provided. Follow that information with the date of publication, Web (as the medium of publication) and date of access.
